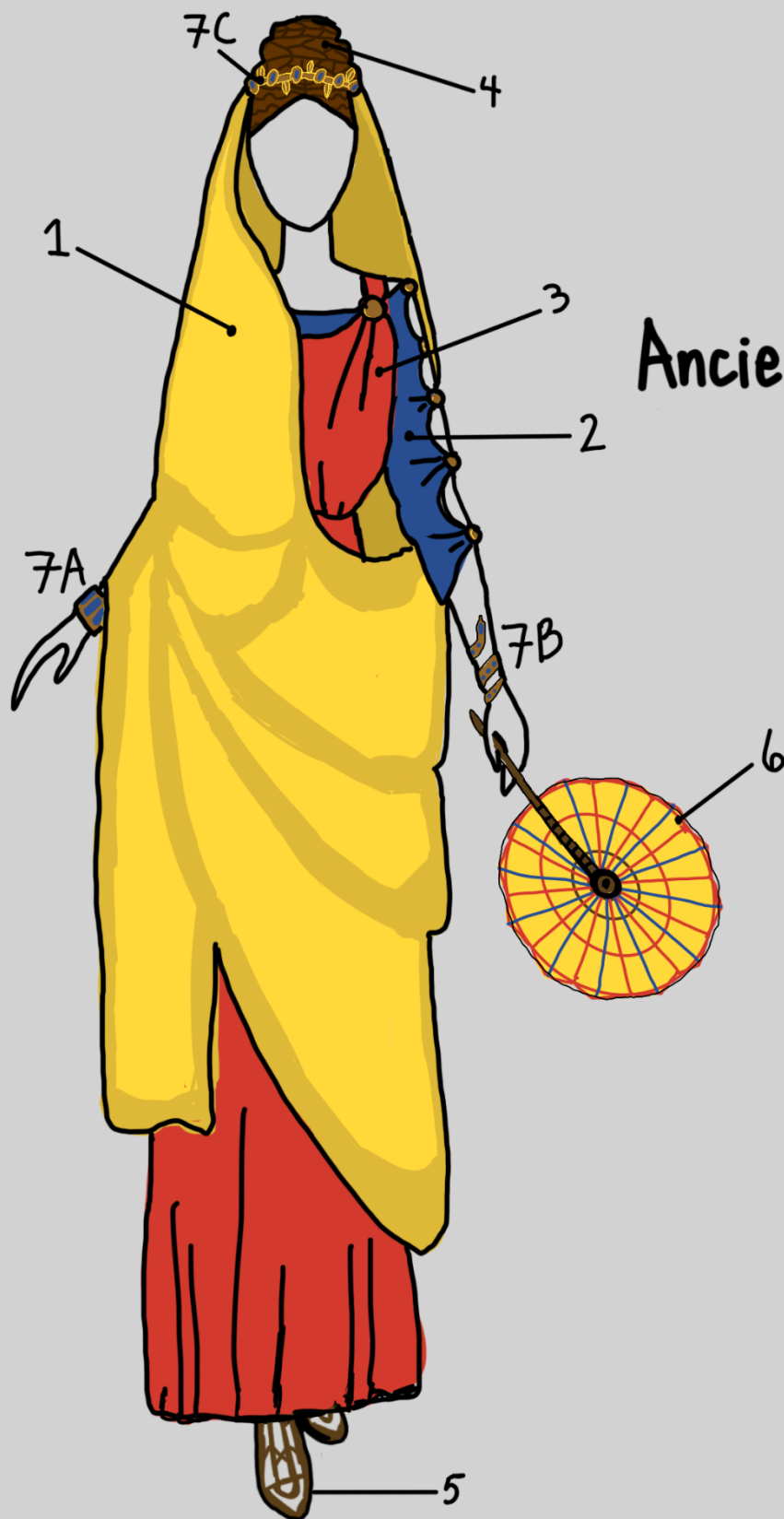




Ancient Rome

1. Palla
2. Under Tunic
3. Stola

A stola was worn only by married women (*Roman Stola | UNRV Roman History*).

4. Tutulus

Tutulus was a specific kind of conical hairstyle reserved for the Mater Familias (Tortora and Marcketti).

5. Sandalis
6. Flabellum
7. Jewelry
 - a. Bracelet
 - b. Snake Bracelet

Snake bracelets were a popular kind of jewelry in Ancient Rome, they were worn with the intention of warding off evil (“Snake Bracelet, 1st Century CE, The Walters Art Museum”).
