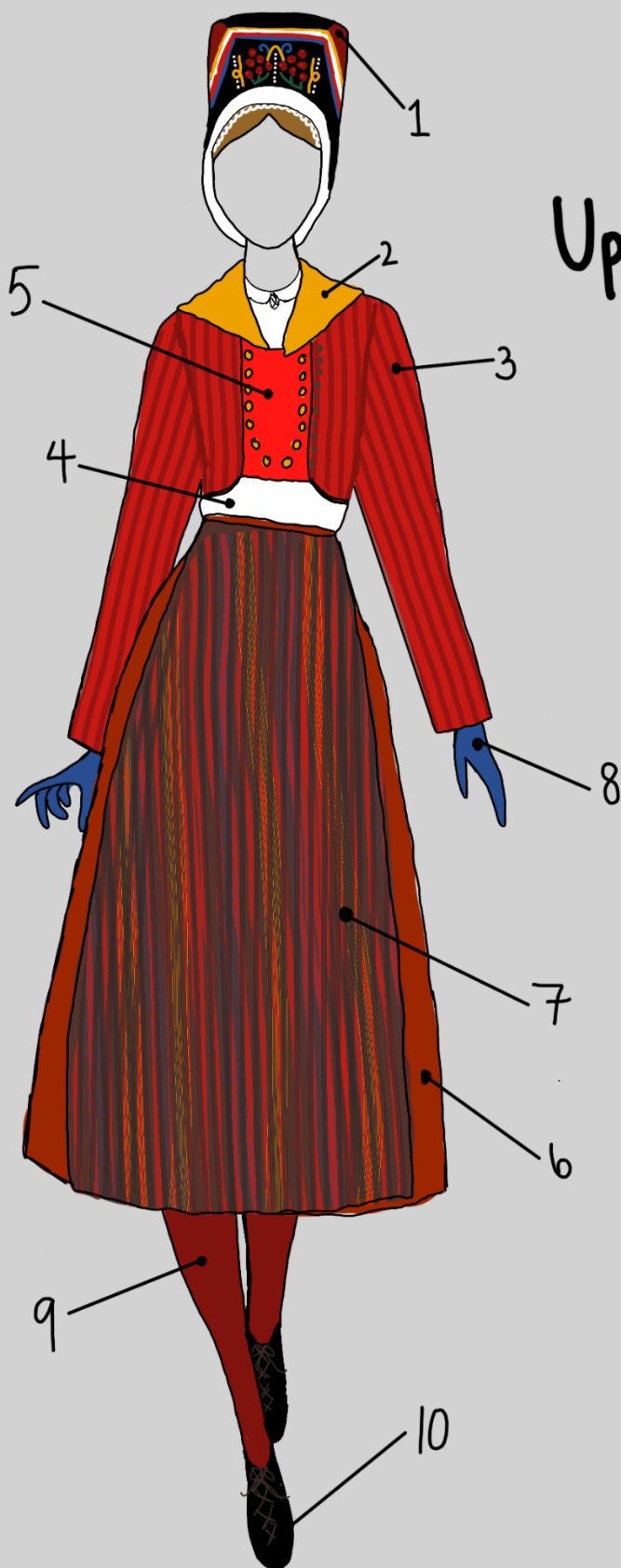


Upplandsdräkt



Swedish Folk Costume - Häverö Upplandsdräkt, c. 1830

1. Högmössa/High Cap

Commonly embroidered with bright colors (red, yellow, blue, etc.) to contrast the snow and pine trees (Skräddare).

2. Silk Shawl
3. Spedetröja/Jacket
4. Blouse
5. Bodice
6. Skirt
7. Apron

The apron, skirt, bodice, and jacket in Upplandsdräkt were all patterned with stripes specific to Uppland, or even more specifically Häverö. I included the most detailed stripes on the apron, using fabric samples as reference (*Uppland*).

8. Gloves

Dark or blue gloves were reserved for married women, as gloves were commonly exchanged by fiancés (*Bridal Gloves, c. 1800–1830*).
